1. Who are we?

We, the «Maimonides» Medical Center, will be referred to as “Medical Center”, websites as “our”. We determine which, with which purpose and how your personal data will be processed.

2. What does the privacy policy cover?

This Privacy Policy applies to our websites.

3. What data do we collect and why?

The data collected is divided into two categories: technical information and data provided by us a user.

Technical information. When you visit our website, some data is collected automatically. We need technical data to operate, support and improve our





site. This includes the following data: IP address, UTM parameters, geolocation, device type and browser type, cookies (cookies) and data about your interaction with the site (session ID).

The session ID includes: your interaction with the site; the name of the website from which you went to our website; the functions of the site you have used; you used the pages on our website; the way you use our website; actions that you take on the site, if any actions are present.

User-provided data. In order to correctly identify and effectively use your donation, be able to return to you from feedback on the results of public collection or the results of use collected funds, as well as be able to identify your payment in order to respond to your further questions, we need your full name, surname, telephone number, billing information and email address.

Note. We do not knowingly process personal data of users under the age of 16. If you are such a user or you are the legal representative of the user, please notify us about this by e-mail service@maimmc.com

4. How long do we keep your data?

We keep your data for 36 months. However, you can exercise your right to delete your data. In this case, your data will be deleted from our servers within 30 days after your request.

5. Do we share data with third parties?

We use your data to carry out statutory activities and fulfill our obligations under the transactions concluded with you and can transfer them on the following grounds: Compliance with the law. We will disclose your personal data to third parties to the extent necessary: ● to comply with a government request, court order or relevant legislation; ● to prevent illegal use of our site or violation of the terms of use of our site and our policies; ● to protect against claims of third parties; ● to help prevent or investigate fraud. Transfer to Third Parties. We transfer your personal data to third parties on the basis of a public offer for processing on our behalf in compliance with technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data - for example, for processing credit cards and payments.

6. Do we transfer your data outside the European Economic Area?

If a transfer is necessary, we apply the necessary data protection measures and ask for your consent, unless the transfer of data is necessary to complete the transaction.

7. What rights do you have over your data?

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- The right to access information. You can ask for an explanation of the processing your personal data.
- The right to portability. You can request all the data that you have provided to us, as well as request data transfer to another controller.





- The right to restrict processing. You can partially or completely deny us to process your personal data.
- The right to delete information. You can send us a request to delete your personal data from our systems.
